

You will need:

- wooden spoons
- acrylic paint & brushes scissors
- white paper
- felt (black, pink, blue, red)
- quick drying glue & tape

WOODEN SPOON PUPPETS... crafts to inspire play



- 1. Wrap some tape around the handles so you can get a nice straight edge to the paint when finished
- 2. Paint the base colour on the spoons for each character, when dry remove the tape
- 3. The fun part start painting on the character details

Now for the finishing touches...

- 4. On a sheet of paper draw ears for Duggee, and the beak for Hennie, and cut them out
- 5. Paint the ears and beak and glue them to the spoons
- 6. For Chew Chew cut two circle ears from black felt and glue on with fabric glue. Repeat for Hennie's feathers
